

Notice of Public Hearing

A public hearing will be held by the Oregon Facilities Authority beginning at 9:00 a.m. on July, 9, 2024. Members of the public can participate in the hearing by dialing toll-free 877-304-9269, and entering passcode 503-802-5765 when prompted. The subject of the hearing is the issuance by the State Treasurer of the State of Oregon, acting on behalf of the State of Oregon and the Authority, of the reissuance and refunding of not more than \$7,397,485.00 aggregate outstanding face amount of tax-exempt bonds (the “Bonds”), the proceeds of which were used to (i) refinance the construction of an approximately 54,500 square foot facility (the “Facility”) that is owned by Samaritan Health Services, Inc. (“Samaritan Health”), a non-profit organization qualified under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the “Code”), and (ii) refinance the acquisition of data management, data storage, and accounting equipment that is owned by Samaritan Health and used at Samaritan Health’s administrative building located at 815 NW 9th Street, Corvallis, Oregon. The Facility, located at 500 N. Santiam Highway, Lebanon, Oregon, is leased to Western University Health Sciences (“Western University”), also a non-profit organization qualified under section 501(c)(3) of the Code, and operated by Western University as a medical school.

The Bonds will not be payable from any funds, assets or tax revenues of the Authority, the State of Oregon or any agency or instrumentality thereof. The Bonds will be payable solely and only from the loan repayments to be made by Samaritan Health.

Interested individuals may express their views, both orally and in writing. Oral comments during the public hearing will be limited to 10 minutes for each speaker.
